

## Local Eats: Stowe's Farms & Food Producers

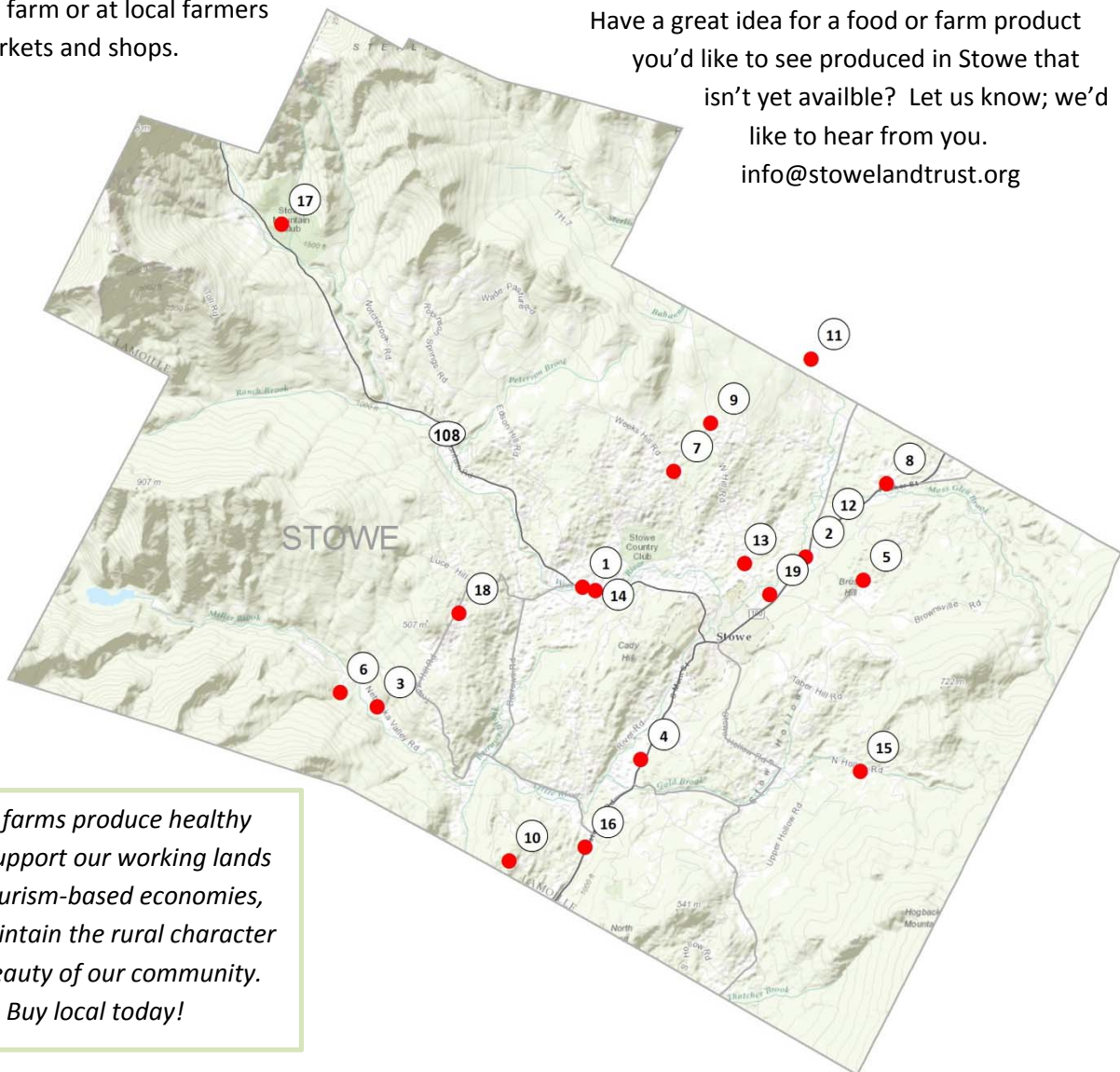
